C/S - WARSAW PACT TROOPS ENTER CZECHOSLOVAKIA

MUNICH, AUGUST 21 (CNR) -- RADIO PRAGUE ANNOUNCED EARLY TODAY
THAT SOVIET, HUNGARIAN, BULGARIAN, POLISH AND EAST GERMAN TROOPS
ENTERED CZECHOSLOVAKIA TUESDAY NIGHT WITHOUT CZECHOSLOVAK PERMISSION.

THE RADIO SAID THAT THE TROOPS BEGAN ENTERING THE COUNTRY

AT 2300 LOCAL TIME TUESDAY NIGHT "WITHOUT THE KNOWLEDGE OF THE

PRESIDENT, THE PREMIER OR THE MEMBERS OF THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY."

THE ANNOUNCEMENT WAS REPEATED EVERY TEN MINUTES AND IT ASKED
THAT THE POPULATION REMAIN CALM AND NOT OFFER RESISTANCE TO THE TROOPS
"ON THE MARCH."

THE TEXT READ:

"TO THE ENTIRE PEOPLE OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK SOCIALIST REPUBLIC, YESTER-DAY, ON 20 TWENTY AUGUST, AROUND 2300 TWENTYTHREE HUNDRED HOURS TROOPS OF THE SOVIET UNION, POLISH PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC, GDR, HUNGARIAN PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC AND BULGARIAN SOCIALIST REPUBLIC, CROSSED THE FRONTIERS OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK SOCIALIST REPUBLIC. THIS HAPPENED WITHOUT THE KNOWLEDGE OF THE PRESIDENT OF THE REPUBLIC, OF THE CHAIRMAN OF THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY, THE PREMIER, AND THE FIRST SECRETARY OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK CENTRAL COMMITTEE.

"IN THE EVENING HOURS THE PRESIDIUM OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK COMMUNIST
PARTY CENTRAL COMMITTEE HELD A SESSION AND SICUSSED THE PREPARATION OF
THE 14TH FOURTEEN CZECHOSLOVAK COMMUNIST PARTY CONGRESS. THE CZECHOSLOVAK COMMUNIST PARTY CENTRAL COMMITTE PRESIDIUM APPEALS TO ALL
CITIZENS OF OUR REPUBLIC TO MAINTAIN CALM AND NOT TO OFFER RESISTANCE
TO THE TROOPS ON THE MARCH. OUR ARMY, SECURITY CORPS AND
PEOPLE'S MILITAI HAVE NOT RECEIVED A COMMAND TO DEFEND THE COUNTRY.
